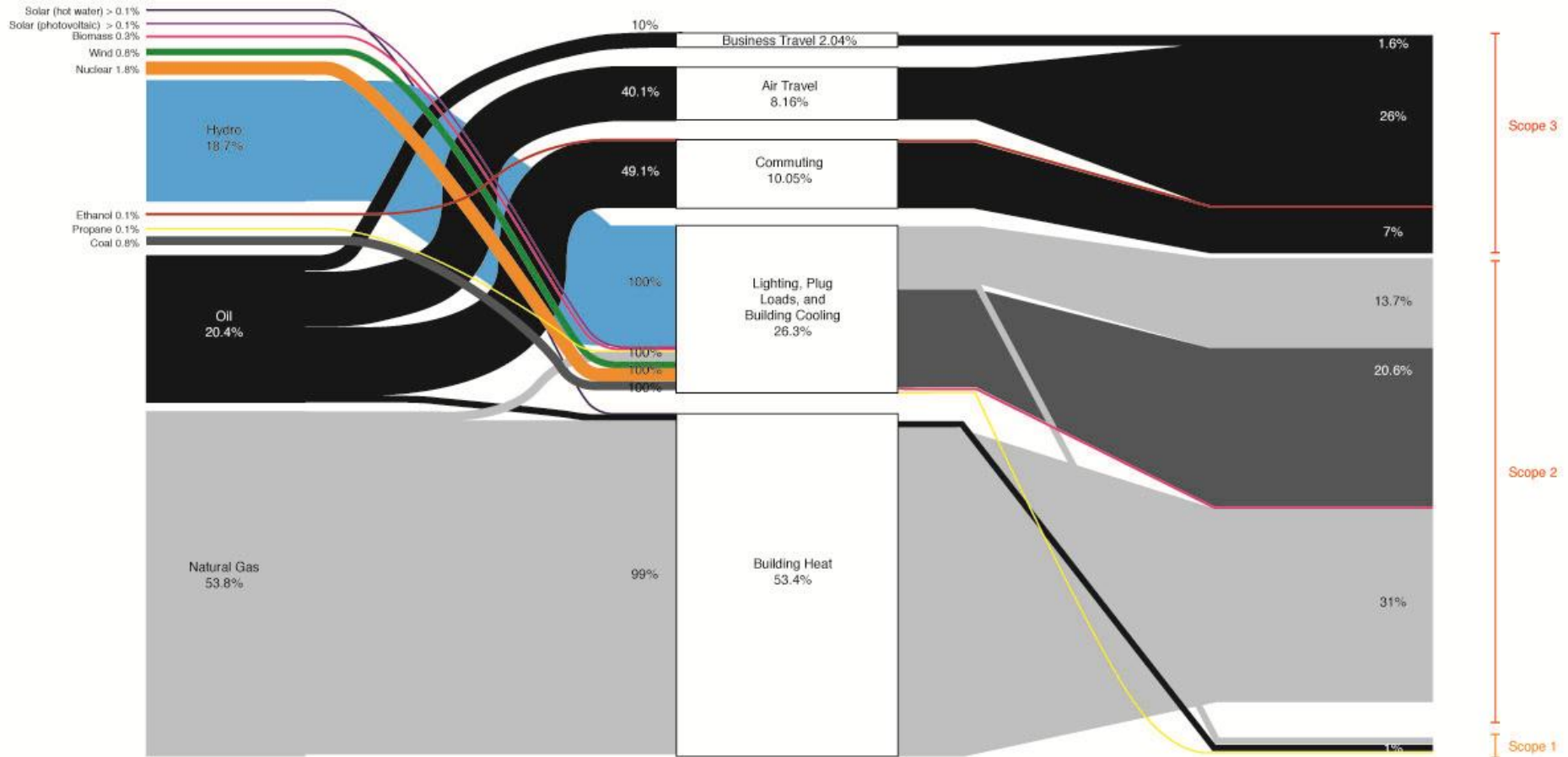


University of Oregon Energy Flow in 2008: Inputs, Activities, and Emissions

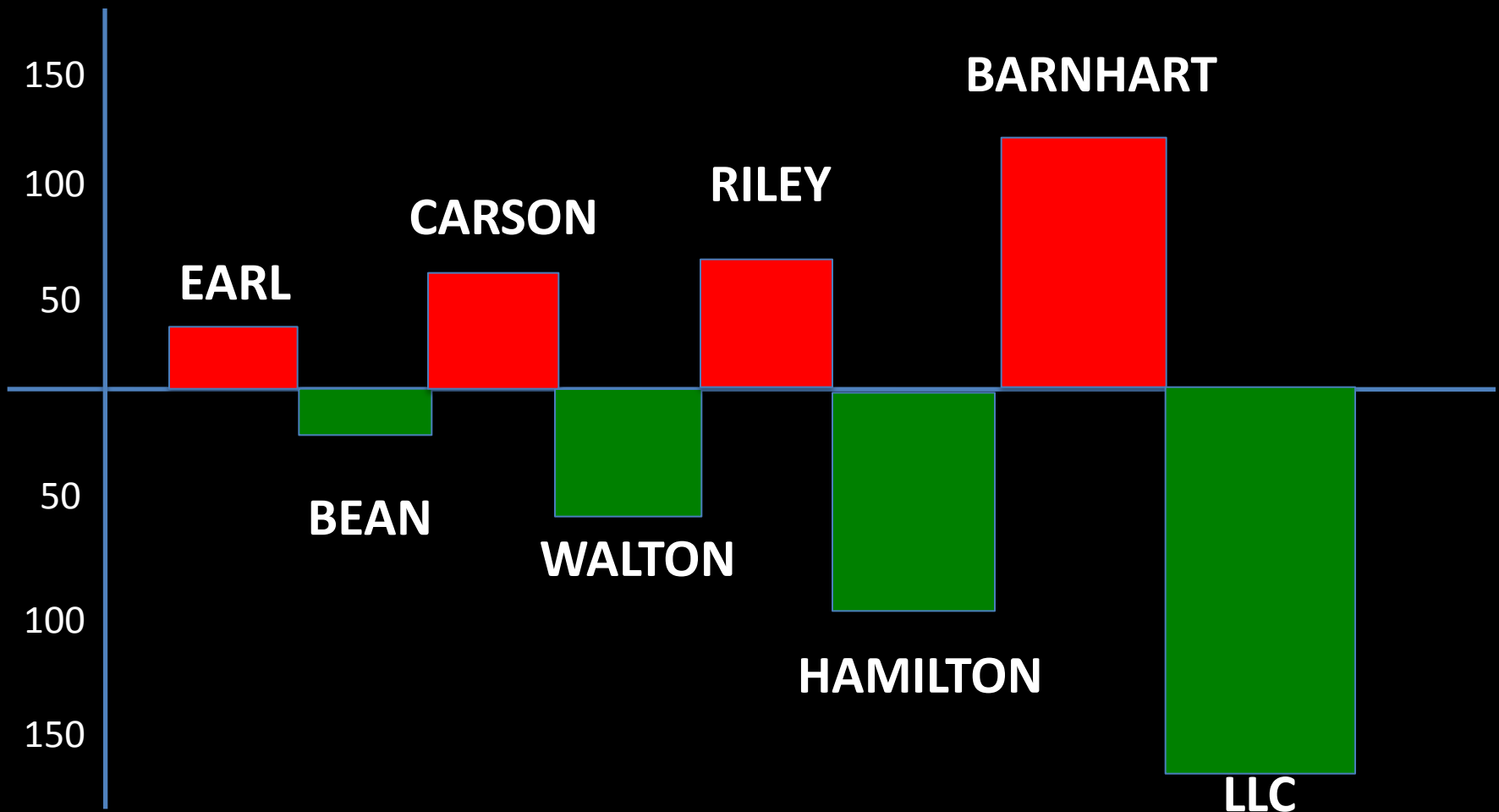
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2010 Results
