Instructions for use

Summary

The present catalogue is a compilation of the archaeological materials collected from various sites in northern Hokkaido, Japan. While some materials from the Nayoro City are purchased from a local individual (probably, by Drs. Sakuzaemon Kodama and Toshio Oba in the School of Medicine of Hokkaido University), origins of majority of the materials are unknown. The materials were collected at least prior to 1966 and some artifacts were presumably collected around 1941. These are 64 materials consisting of ceramic sherds (n = 45), lithic artifacts (n = 9), faunal remains (n = 6), and cobbles (n = 4). Based on the typology of ceramic sherds, they are attributed to various cultural periods, i.e., Jomon, Epi-Jomon, Satsumon, and Okhotsk cultural periods.
