MISCELLANEOUS NOTES ON BRACONIDAE

(Hymenoptera)

Macrocentrus gifuensis ASHMEAD, 1906

This species has been widely known as a parasite of the European corn borer, *Pyrausta nubilalis* HÜBNER. The present specimens, however, were reared by KAWASE from the bean webworm, *Sylep:a ruralis* SCOPOLI, at Takada. According to SUGIYAMA and KAWASE (1952) this species is bred from larvae of *Sylepia ruralis*, feeding on leaves of *Boehmeria tricuspis* MAKINO.²⁾

Hosts: Pyrausta rubilalis HÜBNER and Sylepta ruralis SCOPOLI. Specimens examined: 12 🕾 & 15 우우 20-vi-52, Takada, Niigataken, Japan, H. KAWASE leg.

Distribution : Japan, Korea, Manchuria and Europe.

Tropobracon CAMERON, 1905

On account of FAHRINGER's paper arrived belatedly in Japan, Shirakia VIERECK (1913) was sunken as a new synonym of Tropobracon CAMERON by the writer (1951), but this synonymy had been alreadly established by FAHRINGER (1942).
