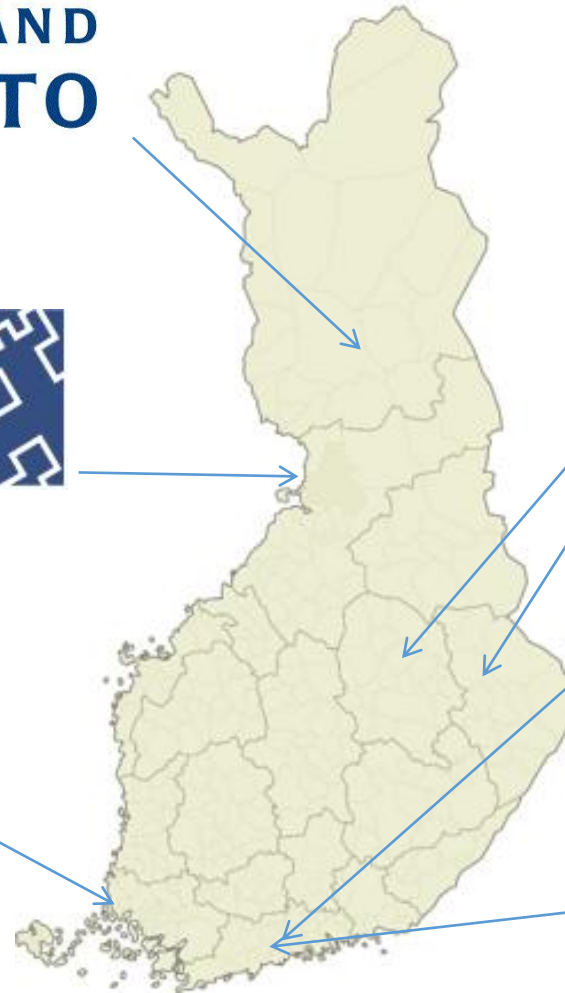

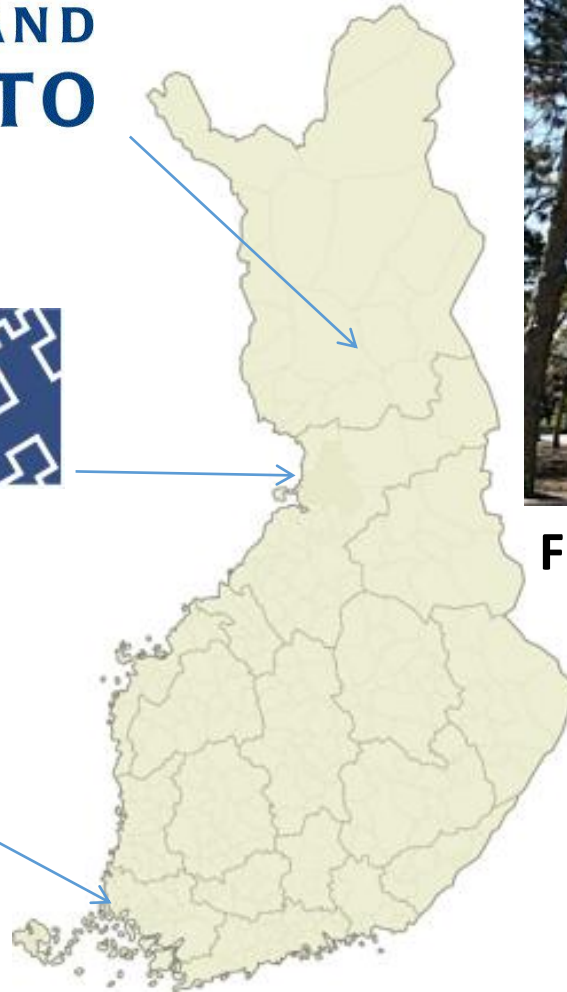

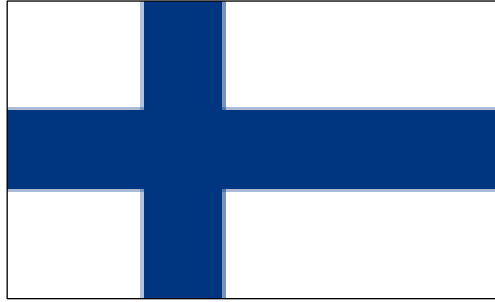
Lakes

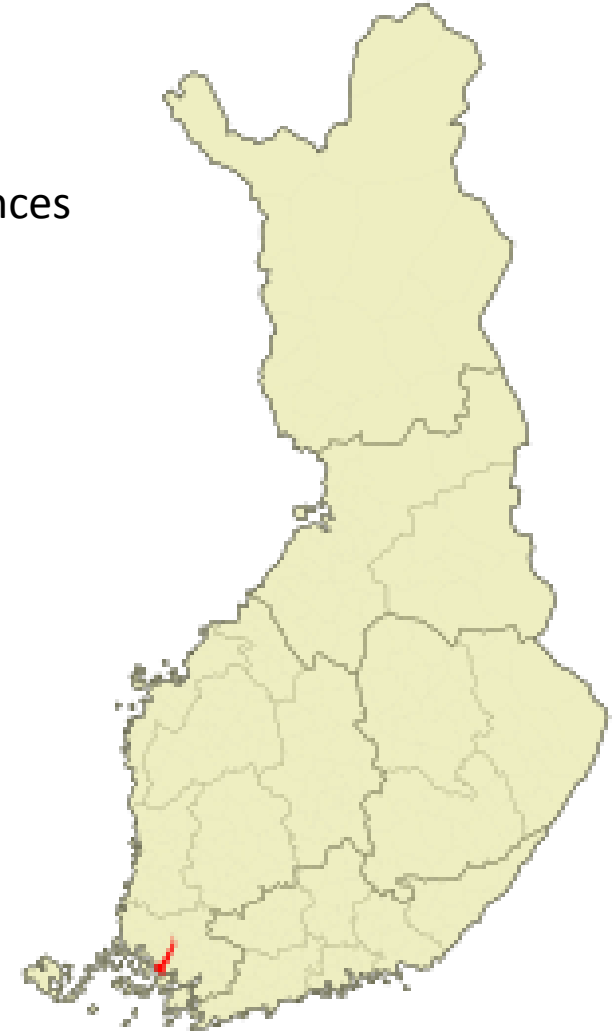

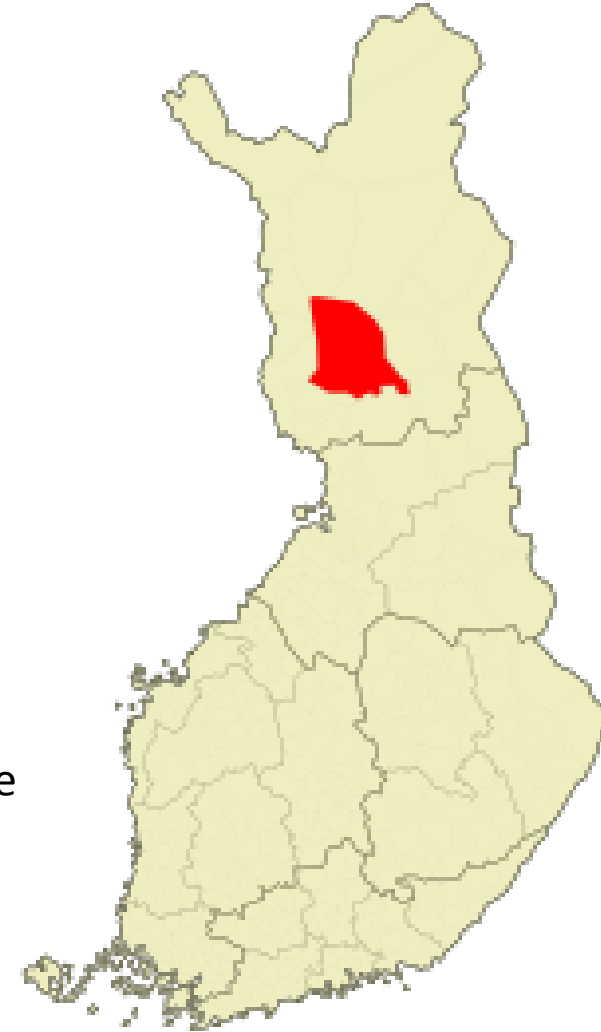
