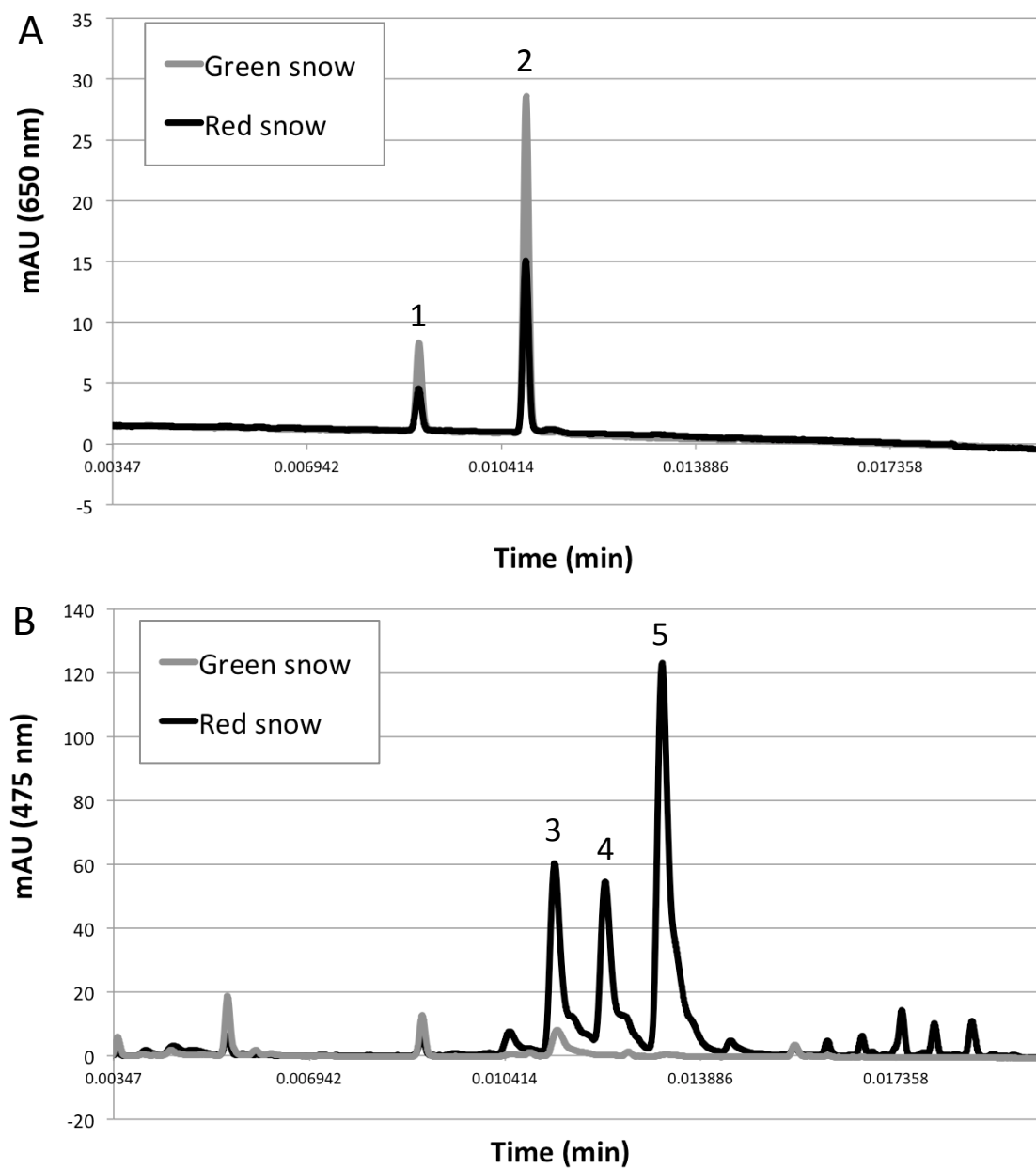


Figure S2. HPLC analysis of pigments extracted from red snow B2 and green snow B2. A. Absorption at 650 nm shows two peaks corresponding to chlorophyll b (peak 1) and chlorophyll a (peak 2). B.
