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## Summary

The present catalogue is a compilation of archaeological materials from the Nakazato site, along with those from localities in the surrounding districts of “Right Terrace,” “Nakazato (Kaji),” and “Bochino-sawa” in Oketo Town, northeastern Hokkaido, Japan. Among the 4557 artifacts listed in this catalogue, a total of 4320 artifacts were excavated from Nakazato, a Paleolithic open-air site, located on the western terrace along the river Bochino-sawa, which converges into the major tributary of the river Tokoro to the south. Artifacts, mainly those made of obsidian (e.g., flakes, blades, blade and microblade cores, and various retouched tools), were recovered from the intensive summer excavation campaigns of the Nakazato site in 1956 and 1957, which were organized by Dr. Sakuzaemon Kodama and Dr. Toshio Oba, both from the School of Medicine of Hokkaido University, with cooperation from Naoi Fujikawa, a local historian, and many local participants from Oketo Town. No formal reports have been published since the termination of the excavations; therefore, the present catalogue is the first formal report of the results of the excavations.
