Citation Count

The number of times cited by other articles is said to be one of the ways to assess how much impact an article has.

Web of science , Scopus etc. provide citation counts. However, there is no single citation analysis that collects all publications and their cited references.

H-index

H-index

It measures both productivity and impact of researcher's publications.

If a researcher has 5 articles that cited more than 5 times, a researcher's h-index is 5.

Reference

A scientist has index h if h of his or her N_p papers have at least h citations each and the other $(N_p - h)$ papers have $\leq h$ citations each.

Be aware: h-index changes according to databases and the date. We recommend that one shows the database's name and the date of calculation. It is difficult to make a comparison beyond disciplines.

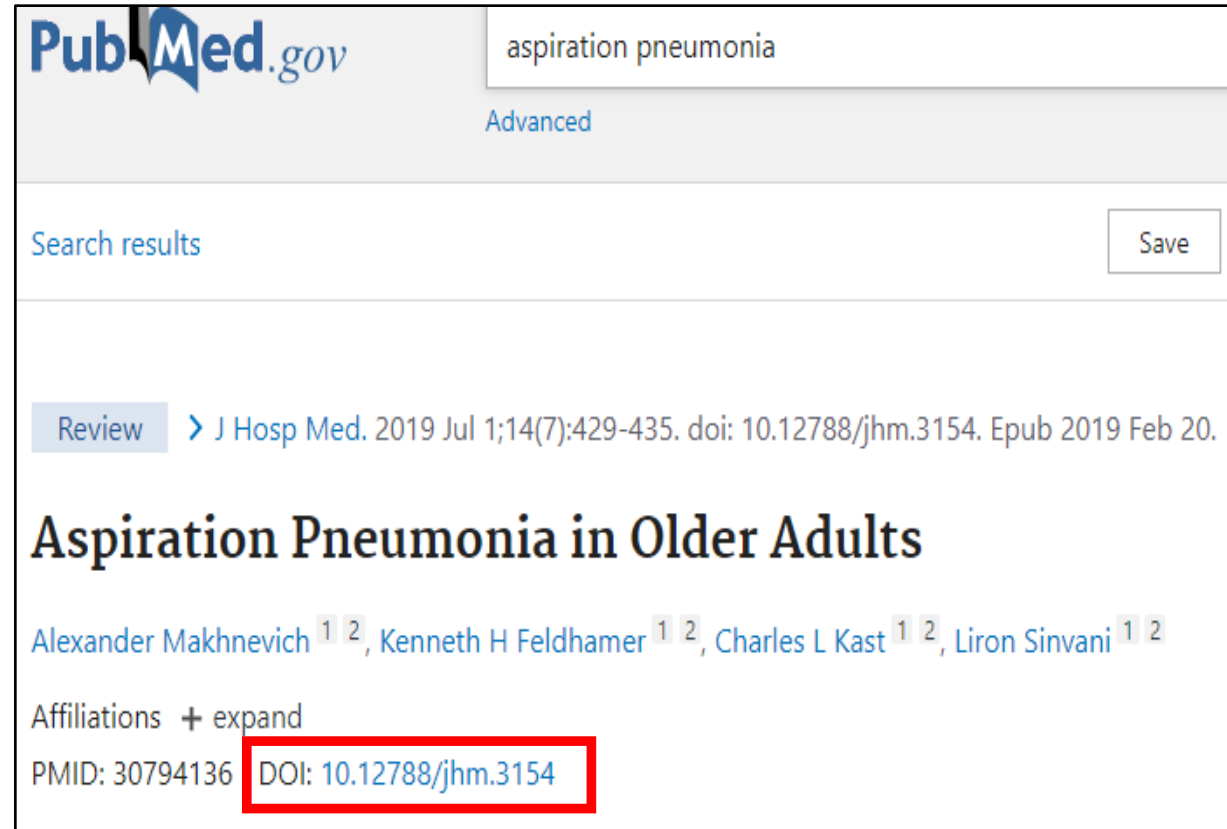

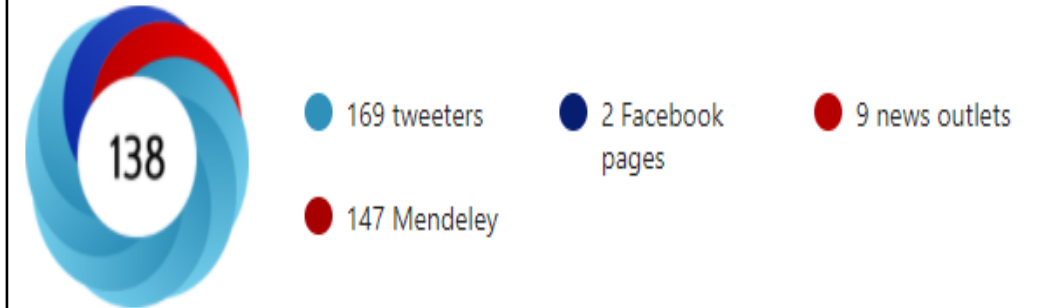

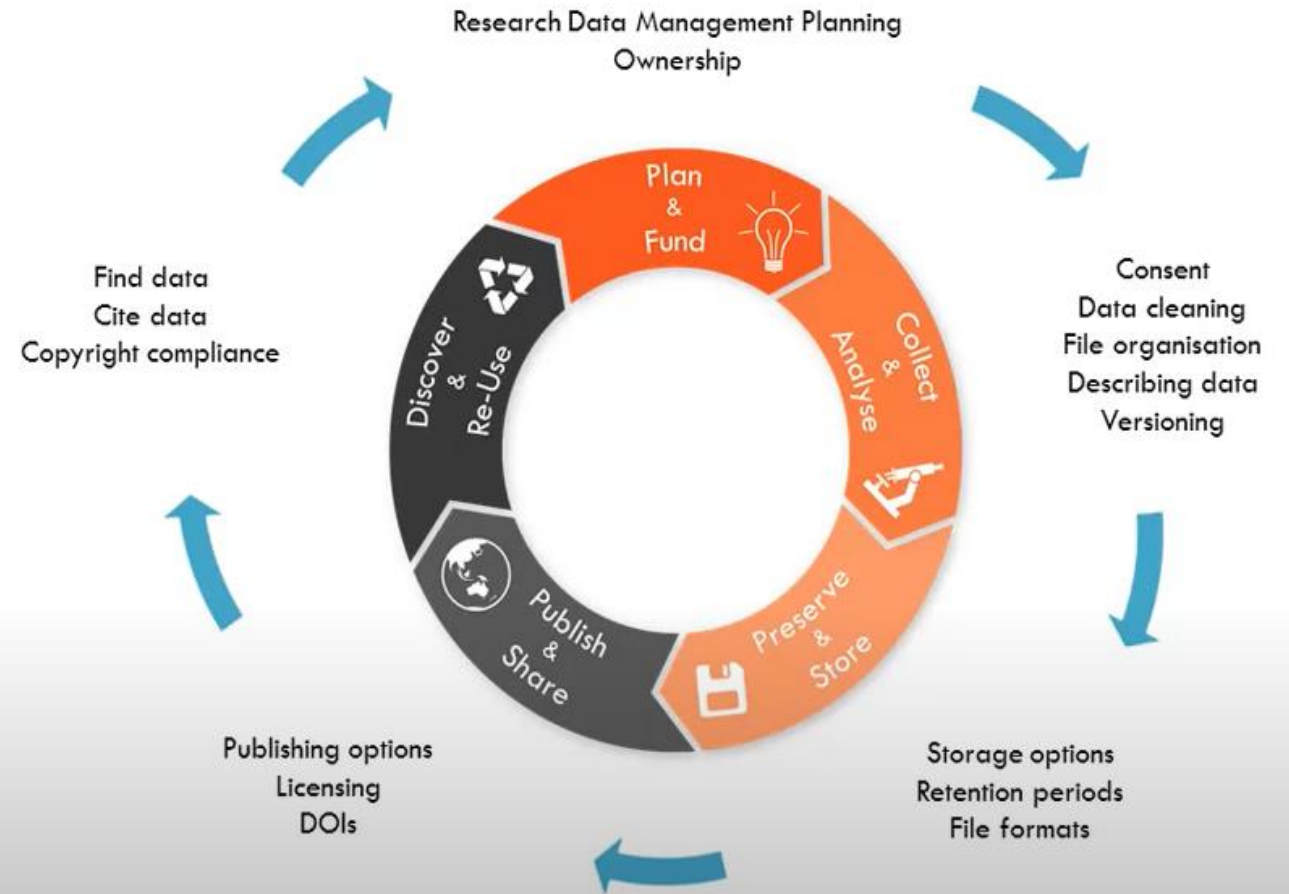

Recent Hot Topic : Research Data Management

Recently, some journal publishers require researchers to make research data underpin their publication openly available.

Also, some of the funding bodies request that researchers make research outcome under their grant openly available.

One of the ways to make research data open is by publishing it in the university's institutional repository.

Data Repository

- University's institutional repository
- Discipline-specific repositories
- General repositories (Figshare, Zenodo etc.)

Choosing appropriate data repository, consider;

- Journal's data policy to which you submit
- Funding body's condition
- Reputable Discipline-specific repositories
- Does the repository charge for uploading data?
- Does the repository provide long term preservation?
- Does the repository provide a Persistent Identifier (ex.DOI)?
- Does the repository apply license to data?
- Does the repository show data repository's policy clearly?
- Does the repository have Credibility?
- Does the repository have a certification, CoreTrustSeal?

Tools for choosing data repositories:

Re3data.org - a global registry of research data repositories that covers research data repositories from different academic disciplines.

Researchers have to consider fully whether the data can be open or not. Please remember that there are some difficult cases such as..

- When you do not have an agreement with your co-researcher.
- When you have restriction on making data open by joint research agreement with corporation.
- When you have restrictions on making data open from legal perspective (privacy, intellectual property, security, sensitive data etc.)
- When traditionally research community has restrictions such as clinical trial, living area of endangered species, interview etc.
